



HOUSE NUMBERS

At least 3" high and Reflective



LANDSCAPING

2 X 6 Rule



LIGHTING- Motion Senor

HOUSE EXTERIOR

DoorsSolid core, no window
Exterior hinges
WindowsAluminum construction
Very pryable

WHAT MAKES AN EXTERIOR DOOR SECURE?

- SOLID WOOD OR METAL
- 8-- NON-REMOVABLE INSIDE HINGES
- 8- NO GLASS IN THE DOOR PANELS
- 8→ 190 DEGREE DOOR VIEWER

ONE THAT'S LOCKED!!

SLIDING GLASS DOORS

- Wooden 2 X 2 in track or Charlie bar
- Install large head screws in upper track to remove lift.
- Key operated auxiliary locks, such as anti-slide block
- Where all panels move, lock down one or more with an L-bracket, top & bottom.
- Security Film

DOUBLE DOORS FRENCH DOORS

- Hardest to secure
- Inactive door can be secured with a cane bolt-1/2" dia. X 12" long at the top & bottom

GARAGE DOORS

- Change opener codes periodically if it's not done automatically.
- Keep garage door & other doors leading from garage to house closed and locked at all times.
- Doors leading from garage into home should have a deadbolt.
- Doors leading from garage to outside "pin" outside hinges

DEAD BOLTS: Single vs. Double Cylinder

- 8 1" Throw
- Receiving hole for deadbolt should be deep enough
- Double Cylinders are normally used when glass is less than 40 inches from locking mechanism.
- ► Double Cylinders- safety hazard

WINDOWS: Sliding Casement





Jalousie

Awning

EXTERIOR LIGHTING

- Motion Sensor Fixtures
- Flood lights
- Mount away from trees
- Check often
- "Sphere of Influence"
